However, individual circumstances may lead us to set a condition, and a department may ask that a condition is set if they have particular concerns.

Applicants who are not nationals of these countries, but who have studied there and completed a qualification equivalent to a UK Bachelor's within two years of the start date of their proposed course of study are also exempt from being set a language condition.
